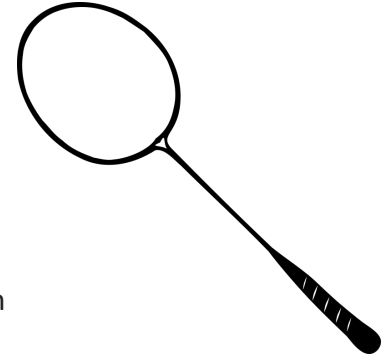
## MEDICATIONS

## GRADE 7 BADMINTON

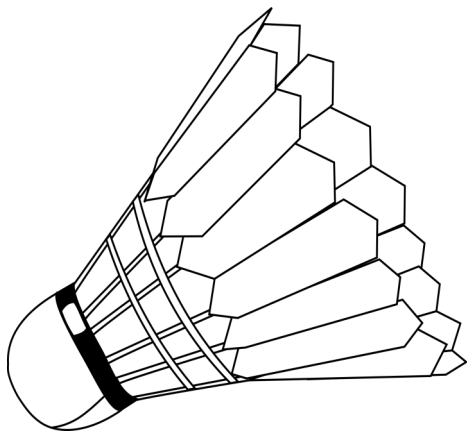
