End of Day Student Pick-Up

As we endeavor to protect teaching time, we are requesting that if you are picking your child up at the end of the school day, please communicate this to your child's teacher (agenda, email, or communication app). Currently, the office team announces "pick-ups" towards the end of the day but, as it causes disruption of teaching time, this practice will be discontinued. We understand that there are unexpected, last minute changes and we welcome your call to the school in these circumstances. This change will take effect on Tuesday, October 10th. Thank you for your assistance with this.

Please remember:

- The start of the day is 9:10 a.m., there is no school supervision prior to this time.
- When dropping off students, the **ONLY** place is at the front doors.
- To call the school prior to 9:30 a.m. if your child will be absent
- Students being picked up early require a note or a phone call to the school
- Dismissal is at 3:50 p.m., if you arrive early please wait in the foyer
- Anaphylactic Allergies and Medical Perils are in this school, please be mindful of others
- Any student that requires medication at the school please ensure a medical release form is completed
- Lockdown Practices will be carried out throughout the school year

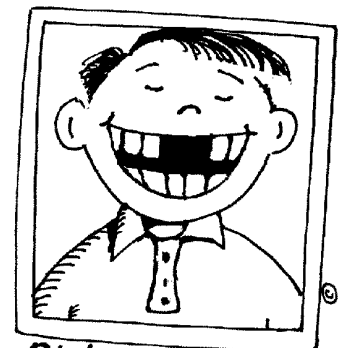

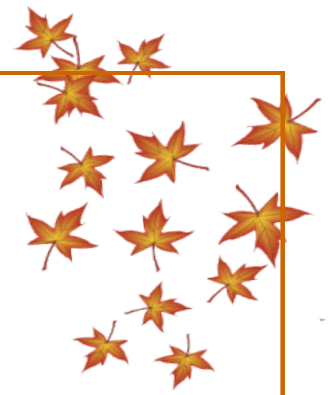

eLibrary

eLibrary is an extensive collection of digital books that can be accessed online, 24/7. Students can browse the growing collection of titles in a variety of subjects including classic and current fiction as well as popular nonfiction titles. Titles can then be borrowed ("signed out") by students using the same username and password that they use to access technology at school. Books can then be read either on or offline after downloading. We do have 5 iPads that are available for loan to students so that they can access this online library. These iPads can be signed out for a week at a time with a signed parent consent. Any students who are interested should check in at the office.
